itinerary

Day 1, Thursday, January 11: Depart for Mexico City

Depart Denver, CO for Mexico City, Mexico and upon arrival, meet your local tour manager.

Pending flight arrival times, transfer to the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe, the most celebrated Marian apparition site in the world. Celebrate the opening pilgrimage Mass at the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Enjoy a special lecture on the history and meaning behind miraculous Tilma. Then transfer to the hotel for check-in. Dinner and overnight in Mexico City

Day 2, Friday, January 12: Metropolitan Cathedral | Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe

After breakfast, take a panoramic tour of the historic square, including the beautiful Church of Nuestra Senora del Pilar and La Profesa Church. Celebrate Mass at the the Metropolitan Cathedral of our Lady of the Assumption, the oldest and largest Cathedral in the Americas. The Cathedral is considered the focus of Mexican cultural heritage and remains the seat of the Archdiocese. It has many spectacular chapels as well as the Crypt of the Archbishops, where every Archbishop of Mexico City has been buried, including Archbishop Juan de Zumarraga. He was the first Archbishop of Mexico City, and the person to whom the Virgin Mary asked Juan Diego to reveal his Tilma, after her miraculous apparition in 1531. Enjoy a group lunch, then return to the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe to tour the Basilica and the surrounding areas including the Old Guadalupe Shrine to learn the story of Juan Diego and the miraculous story of conversion, healing, and the lasting sign of Our Lady's fidelity to the Mexican people. Time for personal devotions to do the rosary walk and visit Tepeyac Hill. Return to Mexico City for dinner at the hotel and overnight.

Day 3, Saturday, January 13: Blessed Miguel Pro | El Altillo

Begin the day with a visit to the Church of the Holy Family. Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Holy Family and venerate the remains of Blessed Miguel Pro, martyr of the persecution of the Church in the 1920s. Walk through the small museum dedicated to the life and martyrdom of Blessed Miguel Pro and learn the history of this inspiring saint who defended the Catholic Faith in Mexico.

Enjoy the opportunity to hear a lecture by Fr. Humberto Pro, the great nephew of Bl. Miguel Pro (pending availability). After lunch, continue to the Church of San Jose del Altillo to see the crypt where Blessed Conchita Cabrera is buried. Blessed Conchita was beatified at the Guadalupe Basilica on July 5, 2019, and is the first Mexican laywoman to receive beatification. Visit the Museum Casa Reliquia Concepcion Cabrera de Armida to view the depth of her mystic writings.

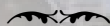
Dinner at the hotel and overnight in Mexico City.




Day 4, Sunday, January 14: Sisters of Mary GirlsTown

Enjoy breakfast, then depart for Girlstown to witness the 'fruits' of Our Lady's evangelization in Mexico. Founded in 1991 by Fr. Al Schwartz, Girlstown Chalco supports over 3,500 middle and high school girls each year by committing to their physical, educational, social, and spiritual well-being. Celebrate Mass with the students of Girlstown and the Sisters of Mary. Tour their campus to understand how lives are being transformed as you spend time playing and interacting with the girls. Enjoy a simple group lunch on Campus. Return to Mexico City for a Farewell Dinner and your final night in Mexico.

Day 5, Monday, January 15: Departure

After breakfast, depart for the Mexico City International Airport for your return flights home.
